designs, hollow built blanks, swells, and a host of other tricks for the lightest and best balanced rods around. Actions are crisp and the rods cast a very flat line. No need to justify owning a cane rod just because it's beautiful or expensive; now you can revel in how well it performs.

Blanks are flamed a medium cognac color and are joined with light weight Super Swiss nickel silver ferrules. Spalted maple wood inserts with engraved nickel silver cap and ring hardware are hand finished and blued. Wraps are

flawless in translucent silk with burgundy silk trim. Blued Snakebrand Guides with select real agate stripping guides in nickel silver frames round out the components. These prized rods are very limited.

Product Line Details

- *Blanks: Hollow built, six sided split bamboo with butt swells flamed a medium cognac color*
- *Ferrules: Super Swiss truncated light weight nickel silver. Ferrules are hand blued and hand fit.*
- *Reel Seat: Spalted maple wood spacer with blued and engraved nickel silver cap and ring.*
- *Grip: Scott standard with finish cork or standard with finish cork*
- *Guides: Snake brand snakes with hand selected real agate stripping guides in nickel silver frames.*
- *Wraps: Clear silk with burgundy silk trim.*
- *Case and Liner: REC aluminum tube with engraved brass end caps and cotton cloth liner.*

G2 Four new models have been added to the G2 series of presentation fly rods. The G2 series is the most successful line of fly rods introduced by Scott, and are designed and built for the

most demanding technical trout anglers. These fly rods have medium actions and a long list of features not found on other fly rods like alignment dots at each ferrule, measuring wraps, hand

inscriptions, natural finish blanks and the Scott hollow internal ferrule.

grip to allow for a second hand assist in casting. Not a true single hander or a double hander, it can be used both ways depending on the type of cast you want to make, your position in the river, or the condition of your arm at the end of a long day.

Shooting Head Special This is a double handed rod for the shooting head fisherman that needs a very fast rod with a lot of 'pop' off the tip when applying power with the bottom hand. Go on, send those heads off to the horizon, you know you want to.

Instructor's Special Students benefit from

seeing the tip of the rod move through the casting stroke. We came up with a blank color that is highly visible both outdoors and in. Yes, it's shocking to see a canary yellow fly rod but your students will sure appreciate it. This is a fast action, very light weight 9 ft. 5 wt that you'll appreciate for teaching.
